**Footnotes**

LAST TANGO (IRE) chased outside a rival or between horses, was shuffled back on the second turn, angled in, came out with a move in upper stretch, rallied to the front three deep under urging in late stretch and was under steady handling at the wire. KISSING GIRL (ARG) saved ground stalking the pace, inched up under a hold leaving the backstretch, came out past midstretch, bid between foes and continued willingly to the wire. IT WAS MEANT TO BE (GB) angled in on the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, inched away into the stretch and held on well but was overtaken late. KERNITRE (GB) saved ground off the pace and pulled a bit, came out on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and found her best stride late. INTRODUCER chased between horses then angled in, went between rivals again on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. POISON IVY (FR) stalked outside a rival then forced the pace outside a foe, dropped back leaving the second turn, steadied in tight past midstretch and weakened. VAMOS NINA (CHI) chased three deep, moved up four wide into the second turn, continued three wide into the stretch and weakened. LUNACY (IRE) close up stalking the pace three deep, fell back into the second turn and gave way. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run but made no change when they ruled POISON IVY was being outrun when the trouble occurred.
