STERLING CAT had good early speed outside, dueled alongside the runner-up, was three deep into the stretch, gained a short lead past midstretch and gamely prevailed under urging. MISS JANUARY broke inward, went up inside rivals then dueled inside the winner but off the rail, drifted in some past midstretch, fought back toward the inside and continued gamely to the wire. PROPOSED chased off the rail, angled in and moved up on the turn, loomed a threat along the rail in the stretch, came out off the heels of the runner-up in deep stretch and went on willingly to the end. WESTERN BLONDY chased a bit off the rail on the backstretch and between horses on the turn and lacked the needed rally. SWISS PLEASE had speed between the top pair then stalked outside a rival, continued three deep on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. BURNING AFFAIR dropped back and angled in early, saved ground off the pace, swung out leaving the turn and into the stretch and was outrun. ARTABEGOOD allowed to settle off the rail, angled in some on the turn and failed to menace.
