Footnotes

NANCY'S ROSE angled in and stalked the pace off the rail, bid outside the runner-up on the second turn and into the stretch, gained the advantage past the eighth pole and drew clear under urging. MEET THE HEAT broke inward, sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, fought back on the second turn and to midstretch, could not match the winner but held second. LITTLE SIERRA stalked outside a rival then off the rail and bested the others. OBASSABA (BRZ) chased inside then a bit off the rail, split rivals on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. HONEELUV DROP saved ground off the pace, went around a rival leaving the second turn, angled in and could not summon the necessary response. RIVER LANE broke out a bit, chased outside a rival, made a brief mild move outside on the second turn then came up empty in the stretch. MUST BE A TOPPER pulled a bit between foes early, angled in and stalked inside, dropped back on the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened.
