### Footnotes

THE FINAL ROAR angled in and dueled outside a rival, kicked clear on the turn, opened up under some left handed urging in the stretch and won clear. FORM A POSSE chased three deep then outside on the turn, entered the stretch alongside a rival, came out some in the drive and just got the place. SEVEN LUCKY J'S between foes early, stalked off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, continued off the inside into the stretch and was edged for second late. DINNER AT JAKE'S a bit slow to begin, settled inside, came three deep into the stretch, then drifted back in and lacked the needed rally. RED JASPER also broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. SAINT CHOCOLATE chased between horses then inside on the turn and weakened in the stretch. SATYRS dueled inside, stalked along the rail on the turn and had little left in the stretch.
