SECRET CIRCLE sped to the early lead, dueled inside, inched away on the turn and drew off in the stretch under a brisk hand ride and a long hold late. BASMATI prompted the pace outside the winner, stalked just off the rail on the turn, was no match in the stretch but clearly second best. TUMMEL chased outside a rival then between foes on the turn and edged a rival for the show. OBSERVANCE was in a good position stalking the pace outside then three deep on the turn and into the stretch and was edged for third. SPIT BALL steadied when squeezed at the start, angled in and moved up inside, continued along the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and finished with some interest. SOUL SAVER saved ground stalking the pace and weakened in the stretch. PEE H DEE settled three deep then off the rail, angled in some on the turn and did not rally. GOOD MOJO chased off the rail then outside a rival on the turn and could not offer the necessary response. GUIDOPANZINI allowed to settle out from the inside, came three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. CRIMSON GIANT broke inward, raced unhurried off the rail then angled in on the turn, came out a bit into the stretch and failed to menace.
