Footnotes

CHARM THE GIANT (IRE) stalked inside, went around a rival leaving the second turn, gained the lead outside the runner-up past midstretch and pulled clear under a tap of the whip and steady handling while drifting out. POLYFIRST (FR) pulled early, stalked the pace off the rail then bid between horses on the backstretch, dueled outside a rival inched away leaving the second turn and just held the place. LOCK AND KEY (IRE) chased between horses then inside, split rivals leaving the second turn, continued inside in the stretch and was edged for second. CANDY FACTORY saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CONVEYOR'S ANGEL pulled her way along three deep, bid outside rivals on the backstretch then stalked off the rail, continued outside on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened, then returned bleeding in the mouth. RED TOP (IRE) three deep early, chased outside a rival to the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. LASIKA (GB) sped to the early lead, set the pace inside then dueled inside the runner-up, dropped back leaving the second turn and gave way.
