GRETSKY pulled a bit early, angled in and chased a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in some and rallied under left handed urging to get up late. PLEASURE TO RIDE wide early, stalked outside a rival, bid alongside a foe into the stretch to gain the lead, kicked clear but was caught late. S. S. STONE chased outside a rival, came out three deep into the stretch, drifted in some, was between foes past midstretch and bested the rest. FORT SUMTER stalked inside, split horses leaving the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DREAM NOW pulled a bit early, angled in and chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. CLEISTHENES rank early, angled in and trailed a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. HAMMURABI sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, kicked clear into the second turn, fought back in midstretch, then weakened. WINNING VOW broke slowly, settled inside then off the rail, came out into the stretch and did not rally. RAINBOW GOOSE four wide early, angled in and stalked off the rail, found the fence on the second turn, dropped back leaving that turn and had little left for the stretch.
