Footnotes

SWEET LULU sped to the early lead and angled in, set all the pace along the inside, drew clear in the stretch and proved best under urging. BELLA VIAGGIA stalked inside then a bit off the rail on the second turn and into the stretch, was no match for the winner but saved the place. ONDINE came off the rail on the first turn, went up three deep on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch and bested the rest. PLAZA DE INDIAS (CHI) unhurried off the rail to the second turn, continued outside leaving that bend and four wide into the stretch and improved position. SELF PRESERVATION stalked outside a rival then between horses on the backstretch, fell back some and found the rail on the second turn and weakened. DOUBLE ANTE chased a bit off the rail, went outside on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. ROYAL TIGER three deep into the first turn, stalked the winner off the rail then between horses into the second turn, dropped back on that turn and weakened.
