Footnotes

SPINELESSJELLYFISH went between horses on the backstretch and a bit off the rail on the turn, angled out into the stretch and rallied gamely under urging to get up at the wire. TZIGANE, was sent along to duel between rivals on the backstretch and outside FIRST TITANIUM on the turn, continued on a short lead inside in the stretch but was caught on the line. SKY JACK, vied for command three deep between rivals, dropped back a bit leaving the turn, but outside the runner-up in midstretch, then drifted out and in and weakened but held third. THE MORRIS MONROE wide early, forced the pace four wide, also dropped back on the turn and weakened. FIRST TITANIUM set or forced the pace along the inside until nearing the stretch and also weakened. BLOWIN EASY, squeezed a bit at the start, was sent between horses, continued outside COWBOY BALLAD on the turn and dropped back. LET'S GO SURFING, broke out and was bumped, was in a bit tight briefly on the backstretch, split rivals three deep midway on the turn, continued wide into the stretch and did not rally. COWBOY BALLAD broke out a bit, then had a rail trip and weakened. HOT VIDEO, squeezed a bit at the break, settled off the rail, went four wide on the turn and wider into the stretch and was not a factor. MARGEDS DITTO, raced wide throughout and was outrun.
