Footnotes

OFFICER dueled on a short lead between horses under a long hold, inched away on the turn, angled in and drew off under a loose rein. CROWN THE KING dueled three deep between horses on the backstretch, stalked between foes on the turn, was no match thereafter but clearly second best. BID N ASK between horses early, chased off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and picked up the show late. SHARPER TOO had good early speed and pressed the pace inside, stalked along the rail on the turn, then weakened and was edged for third. ROBERTO'S SHOW prompted the pace four wide on the backstretch, tracked the leader three deep on the turn and also weakened. PHONEY GOLD close up five wide early then off the rail on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
