ONE UNION sped to the early lead, set the pace inside or a bit off the rail, inched away again on the second turn and held on gamely between foes under urging. AWESOME GEM settled outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, angled out, was bumped in midstretch and surged late five wide on the wire. DARK ISLANDER (IRE) saved ground stalking the pace, moved up inside on the second turn, slipped through tight quarters along the rail with a bid in the stretch and continued willingly to the end. WORLDLY (GB) pulled his way along early, chased a bit off the rail or between horses, came three deep into the stretch and surged between rivals on the line. STONESIDE (IRE) broke a bit slowly, settled inside chasing the pace, came out in deep stretch and also finished gamely between horses late. PORTO SANTO (FR) settled off the pace inside, came out into the stretch, was bumped between horses and steadied in midstretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. BONJOUR (NZ) chased outside, went three wide on both turns and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the needed rally. BECRUX (ITY) chased three deep then outside a rival, went three wide leaving the second turn and into the stretch, was bumped in tight quarters between foes in midstretch and did not rally. LANG FIELD pulled between horses then stalked outside a rival, bid alongside the winner on the backstretch, tracked that one outside a foe on the second turn, was bumped and in tight in midstretch and weakened. ALL MAN stalked the winner inside, came out into the stretch and also weakened.
