Footnotes

BRUCE'S DREAM chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up on the wire. COLGAN'S CHIP stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid between horses on the second turn then outside the pacesetter, took the lead into the stretch, inched away in deep stretch and held on gamely but was edged on the line. CAYAMBE broke inward, stalked off the rail, bid three deep into the second turn, continued off the inside into the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and bested the others. SWIFT WINDS saved ground chasing the pace, came out in deep stretch and went around a rival on the line but lacked the needed rally. TRIUMPHANT FLIGHT came in after the start, sped to the early lead then pulled and drifted out a bit on the first turn, set the pace just off the rail then inside, dueled on the second turn, fought back in the stretch and weakened late. BOLD CHIEFTAIN in a bit tight just after the start, chased off the rail then inside, came under urging on the second turn, angled out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally.
