SUGGESTIVE BOY (ARG) pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside, came out in upper stretch, bid between foes in midstretch, bumped with his rivals past the eighth pole, gained a short lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. CALIMONCO stalked the pace outside the winner, came three deep into the stretch, bid four wide in midstretch, was bumped past the eighth pole and continued willingly. KEY DECISION (ARG) pulled early and stalked a bit off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, fought back off the rail, came out a bit and bumped with the winner past the eighth pole and held third. MIDNIGHT INTERLUDE chased a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and finished with interest but missed third. VENOMOUS (GB) angled in and saved ground off the pace, moved up some leaving the second turn, came out in the stretch and split foes late. VICTORY PETE sped to the early lead outside a rival then angled in and set the pace inside, dueled on the second turn and until midstretch and weakened late. EL GATO MALO angled in and settled a bit off the rail, fell back outside a foe leaving the second turn and lacked a further response. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled KEY DECISION was responsible for the contact past the eighth pole.
