Footnotes

MARCYJANE chased between horses then a bit off the rail, continued between foes on the second turn, came out into the stretch, was in tight when boxed in briefly nearing midstretch, angled in and rallied between rivals under left handed urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. SIDEPOCKET RUN five wide leaving the chute, settled off the rail then outside, went three deep on the second turn, circled five wide into the stretch and finished well. VAN DIEN AVENUE four wide in the chute, angled in and chased outside a rival then between foes on the backstretch, continued just off the fence on the second turn, came out in upper stretch, drifted out some nearing midstretch but rallied between horses late. HOT AND PLEASING stalked inside then between rivals on the backstretch and second turn, bid alongside the pacesetter in midstretch then between foes in deep stretch and continued willingly but was outfinished. TICKLE AGAIN saved ground tracking the pace, cut the corner into the stretch, bid along the inside past midstretch and also was outfinished. PATRIOT C H sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, came off the rail into the stretch, fought back in the drive and weakened late. ITSABEAUTIFULDAY bumped just after the start, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace throughout and lacked the needed rally. I'M NO PATSY close up stalking the pace outside a rival then a bit off the rail, was between horses midway on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. DOW DIVA pulled her way along to chase the pace three wide to the stretch and lacked a late response. STELLAR ATMOSPHERE bumped just

after the break, stalked three deep, dropped back leaving the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
