STORMY JACK settled outside, went three deep on the second turn and rallied gamely under urging to get up late. BUSTER B BIMBO sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, responded gamely in the stretch and held on well but was caught late. JEKYLL AND HYDE in a bit tight off heels into the first turn, saved ground stalking the pace, awaited room inside leaving the second turn, got through in midstretch, bid inside and went gamely to the wire. WHYOME (IRE) steadied in tight between horses into the first turn, chased between rivals on the backstretch and second turn, was boxed in behind and between foes in midstretch, swung out and finished well. TENDER OFFER (IRE) pulled four wide early, tracked the pace three deep on the backstretch and second turn, split rivals with a move forward in the stretch and was in a bit tight nearing the wire. LOYAL TARTARE (FR) off a bit slowly and bobbed when he appeared to clip heels after the start, saved ground unhurried, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and put in a late bid. HERITAGE HALL (IRE) in tight inside into the first turn, saved ground stalking the pace, waited along the rail on the second turn and could not offer the necessary late resposne. WITH IRIS stalked the pace off the rail to the second turn, continued outside a rival and weakened in the final furlong. HEMMINGSWAY pulled three deep between foes early, chased between horses on the backstretch, continued outside a rival on the second turn and weakened. SILVER AXE unhurried off the rail early, came wide into the stretch and failed to menace.
