Footnotes

BRING THE HEAT stalked the pace toward the inside then a bit off the rail, bid outside the leader and took a short lead past midstretch, then pulled clear under left handed urging. SWEDISH SIGHTS chased off the rail then between horses leaving the backstretch and on the turn and split foes late for second. CRESCENDO bumped at the start., sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back in midstretch, could not match the winner and lost the place late. TIZ ADAPTABLE off a bit slowly and forced in some at the gap, saved ground off the pace, came out in upper stretch and found his best stride late. SWORDFISH was in a good position stalking the pace outside on the backstretch and four wide on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. APALACHEE'S NATIVE bumped at the start, angled in early and saved ground stalking the pace but could not offer the necessary response. FLYLIKETHEWIND close up stalking the pace outside the winner then three deep on the turn, was a bit tight off heels into the stretch while dropping back and weakened.
