Footnotes

NOSE THE TRADE (GB) three deep into the first turn, dueled outside a rival, inched away and angled in on the second turn, kicked clear in the stretch and just held on under urging. FLEETSTREET DANCER between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail, went around a rival leaving the second turn, swung out into the stretch and closed gamely to just miss. CRAFTY C. T. pulled a bit early, chased outside a rival then off the rail, went four wide leaving the backstretch and three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and bested the others. CONSISTENCY four wide into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, went three deep into the second turn, continued a bit off the rail and lacked a further response. JIMMY Z unhurried inside for six furlongs, moved up some leaving the second turn, came out in the stretch and improved position. SARAVA bobbled at the start and was off a bit slowly, went three deep on the first turn, chased outside a rival, swung three wide into the stretch and did not rally. GIFT OF THE EAGLE saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and weakened. LIKE A HERO taken off the rail early, raced unhurried off the inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. BONUS PAY DAY had good early speed and dueled inside, dropped back on the second turn, steadied while weakening leaving that bend and gave way.
