MEGAHERTZ (GB) stalked the pace outside a rival, swung three deep into the stretch, rallied gamely four wide under urging through the drive to get up late. TATES CREEK stalked a bit off the rail, bid between horses on the backstretch, took a short lead in the second turn, inched away, drifted in under urging in midstretch and held on well but was caught late and shared the place. DUBLINO saved ground tracking the pace, came off the rail on the second turn, rallied between horses through the final furlong and also went willingly to the wire. GOLDEN APPLES (IRE) stalked the early leader outside, bid three deep on the backstretch and second turn and also continued gamely between rivals to the end. VOZ DE COLEGIALA (CHI) took the early lead and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail, fought back on the second turn, was in a bit tight inside rail in midstretch and weakened.
