ALL DE VICTORS chased off the rail or outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up in midstretch, gained the lead under urging nearing the sixteenth pole and won clear. ARAGORN SWORD pulled his way to the early lead, angled in on the first turn, set a pressured pace inside, inched away a bit off the rail on the second turn, fought back inside the winner in midstretch, could not match that one in the final sixteenth but held second. APPLY hesitated to be away slowly, angled in and settled inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the show late. STIRRED UP saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn, also swung four wide into the stretch and was edged for the show. SHOWMETHEMONEYJIM was in a good position stalking the pace inside, inched forward on the backstretch and second turn to loom a threat but weakened in the stretch. VICTORIASUGRDADDY saved ground chasing the pace, continued inside on the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. ET TU WALKER broke a bit slowly, was well placed chasing the pace outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. RESPUESTA SOLIDA three wide on the first turn, angled in and chased outside a rival, found the rail leaving the second turn, continued inside and lacked a further response. VERY UNUSUAL angled in and stalked off the rail, bid alongside the leader on the backstretch, fell back leaving the second turn and weakened. T J'S PASSION chased outside a rival then three deep leaving the backstretch, dropped back between horses leaving the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
