Z Z WAY stalked inside, came out into the stretch, took the lead alongside the runner-up in midstretch and inched away late under urging. COMPULSIVE sped to the early lead outside, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner late but held second. SALT POWER stalked between horses, angled to the inside leaving the turn, came out a bit past midstretch and was edged for the place. GOLDEN DYNAMO chased between horses then outside a rival or just off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. SHORT SWORD settled off the pace inside, came out on the turn and five wide into the stretch and improved position but was not a threat. HECTOR O broke a bit slowly and awkwardly, pulled between foes and was in a bit tight early, chased outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. BLACK TIE stalked between horses then three deep to the stretch and weakened. PUNXSUTAWNEY PHIL hopped then steadied in a slow start, went up four wide on the backstretch and outside on the turn, angled in off the rail into the stretch and gave way in the drive.
