By subscription of \$100 each, which shall accompany the nomination, or by supplementary nomination of \$1,500 each by Sunday, July 21, \$1,000 additional to start, \$150,000 and an additional \$50,000 from Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The host association's monies to be divided 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 12% to third; 6% to fourth and 2% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided, provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Footnotes

DISTURBINGTHEPEACE sent between horses early, forced or stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the turn, bid outside the runner-up in the stretch, gained the advantage past the eighth pole and proved best under some urging. FREESPOOL sped to the early lead and pulled some under a hold between horses, inched away and angled in on the turn, fought back when challenged in the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. MELLOW FELLOW saved ground, moved up inside leaving the backstretch, continued inside on the turn, came a bit off the rail in the lane and edged a rival for third. IMPRESSIVE GRADES between horses early, chased outside then three deep into the turn, continued outside on the bend and just missed the show. KOMAX settled off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, angled inward in the stretch and made up some ground but was not a threat. D'WILDCAT unhurried outside a rival then a bit off the rail, found the fence on the turn, was crowded off heels in upper stretch, came out and did not rally. ASTONISHED (GB) prompted the pace three deep on the backstretch, stalked outside the winner on the turn and off the rail into the stretch and weakened. NUCLEAR DEBATE allowed to settle outside, advanced three deep on the turn, came a bit wider into the stretch and lacked a rally. MEN'S EXCLUSIVE chased off the rail or between horses, dropped back into the stretch and weakened.
