HOLLYWOOD HONEY fractious in the gate, bobbled sharply in opening strides, unhurried early, swung out leaving the backstretch, advanced three wide around the bend, bid three deep passing the sixteenth marker and collared foes late to prove much the best. ENDURING FREEDOM quickly sped to the front and secured the fence, set a pressured pace to the lane, resisted when challenged but could not stave off the winner late. LA BELLA REINA forced the early pace while pulling hard, bid outside rival approaching the stretch, continued outside that foe and fought gamely to the wire. ADIOS MEADOWLAKE prominent early from along the rail, came out a bit in upper stretch and finished evenly. ALPINE SINGER between foes early, in a bit tight leaving the backstretch, dropped back a bit, drifted out slightly in upper stretch and failed to menace. HERE COMES BIG G close up while three deep, raced inside winner around the turn, drifted out slightly and weakened.
