MARIE'S ROSE stalked inside then off the rail into and on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and rallied under some urging and good handling to prove best. SPRING OF PEARLS (IRE) had good early speed and duelled inside, kicked clear on the turn, remained clear in the stretch but could not hold off the winner. MADISON MEADOWS off a bit awkwardly, settled just out from the rail then angled in, moved up inside leaving the turn, came a bit off the fence in the stretch and bested the rest. DANAMORADA (BRZ) chased between horses on the backstretch and turn, angled to the inside into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LADY'S CHAMPAGNE (ARG) allowed to settle outside then chased three deep, continued off the rail on the turn, angled in some entering the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. LADY MARQUISE (NZ) chased between horses then outside, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. DEER MACKIE sped to the early lead then pressed the pace outside the runner-up, stalked on the turn, was between foes into the stretch and also weakened. GLAMOUR CAT chased outside on the backstretch, dropped back off the rail on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
