Footnotes

KEY LIME TIME dueled between horses then inside midway on the turn and through the stretch, inched away under left handed urging in deep stretch and held gamely. REBELLIOUS unhurried off the rail or outside, came three deep into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and closed with a rush. RACY ACK chased outside, bid four wide then three deep on the turn to take the lead, battled outside the winner in the stretch and weakened some late but held third. TAMERLANE SPICE chased between horses then a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and was edged for the show. HEAVONS CAPER stalked a bit off

the rail or inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. JACO'S MISTRESS had good early speed then dueled three deep, battled between foes on the turn and weakened in the stretch. MISSANNALOUISE broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, came around a rival into the stretch, found the rail and was not a threat. TRUE HEAT chased between horses then outside a rival on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and did not rally. MUSIC RECITAL broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, also came four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. DANCIN GYPSY chased three deep, dropped back on the turn and was not a factor. SMOKING HOOVES chased four wide on the backstretch, fell back on the turn and had little left for the stretch. SWAN CREEK off a bit slowly, was sent along inside to duel for the lead, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
