SING SING CINDRELA prompted the pace inside a rival then stalked alongside a foe on the turn, re-bid outside the leader into the stretch, gained a short advantage in midstretch, inched away, fought back through the final sixteenth and held gamely under urging. LIT DE BET went up inside to stalk the pace, saved ground on the turn, was in tight off heels into the stretch, came out nearing midstretch, bid alongside the winner in deep stretch and continued willingly. VICTORIOUSLY had speed outside rivals then set a pressured pace outside the winner, inched away into the turn, continued along the rail, fought back until past midstretch and just held third. APPEALING AFARE stalked between horses, dropped back into the turn, angled to the inside on the bend, continued along the rail in the stretch and was edged for the show. BERRY VALID stalked between horses or a bit off the rail, came out slightly and had the rider lose the whip into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SMALL BUT MIGHTY had speed between horses then stalked four wide, continued three deep into the turn, came out four wide again into the stretch and weakened. MOON STONE MADNESS chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and also weakened.
