Footnotes

MANEWAL dueled for the lead on the inside down the backstretch and around the turn, inched clear at the top of the stretch and drew away in the final furlong under steady hand urging. PRIMED AND READY bobbled at the start, chased off the rail, moved closer around the turn, came into the lane four wide, rallied in the middle of the track and was up for the place on the wire. CONFEDERATE RECON dueled for the lead outside the winner down the backstretch and around the turn, could not match strides at the top of the lane, weakened in the final furlong and was edged for the place on the wire. BUBBA FIZZ chased on the inside down the backstretch, came out on the turn, angled back towards the rail for the stretch drive and improved his position in the final furlong. BACKSTREET BOSS stalked the dueling pacesetters off the rail down the backstretch, came into the stretch three wide and weakened in the final furlong. DISARM stalked off the rail, came into the stretch three wide and did not offer a rally in the drive. GENERALLY OURS chased the pace on the inside throughout and did not offer a rally in the lane.
