COLLATING LADY four wide early, angled in and chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, moved up inside leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch, bid between foes nearing midstretch to gain the lead and inched away under urging. DYNAMIC DIVA between horses early, chased outside a rival then just off the rail, came out into the second turn, went four wide past the quarter pole, bid three deep into the stretch then outside the winner, could not match that one but was clearly second best. HUNTINGTON HARBOUR pulled and stalked inside, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and edged a rival for the show. CEE'S THE YEAR angled in and chased inside, came out into the stretch, split horses past midstretch and was edged for third. SHESKEY chased outside then alongside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. FREEWAYRACER sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, opened a commanding lead on the backstretch and second turn but shortened stride and weakened in the stretch. FARRARI STONE angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch then angled back in and did not rally. BONITA MONTANA stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail, dropped back between foes leaving the second turn, gave way and was eased in the final furlong. KATIE'S TEN four wide early then three deep on the first turn, chased outside, dropped back on the second turn, was pulled up leaving that turn and vanned off.
