**Footnotes**

CUSTOMER BASE chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the second turn, came out a bit then angled in off heels in midstretch, bid inside, took a short lead in deep stretch and held under some urging. CAMELIA ROSE (FR) between rivals in the chute, angled in and chased just off the rail then inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, bid outside the winner past midstretch and continued willingly to the wire. ROCK AND GLORY had good early speed and pulled her way along to set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the second turn, kicked clear off the rail in the stretch, was between foes a sixteenth out and held third. SCORE BOYERA settled off the pace inside, saved ground to the stretch, continued inside in the drive and was edged for the show. DIAMOND DUCHESS (IRE) chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch, waited off heels between foes in midstretch and was outfinished. SUZETTES FRIEND had speed outside a rival then stalked just off the rail, bid alongside that one into the second turn, tracked again to the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. GEM OF SOUL (BRZ) pulled inside then came out on the backstretch, went between foes then three deep on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CAMILLE C four wide in the chute, chased outside a rival then between horses on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. LINDA LOU reared at the start to be off slowly, settled off the rail, went outside foes on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the drive.
