RICHARD'S KID saved ground chasing the pace, came out for room on the final turn, went three deep leaving that turn, angled out into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up in midstretch, gained the lead and drifted in past midstretch and proved best under some left handed urging. WORTH REPEATING stalked a bit off the rail, took the lead outside a rival leaving the second turn, battled outside that one on the backstretch, kicked clear on the last turn, fought back inside the winner in midstretch, could not match strides with that one but was clearly second best. BALLADRY stalked off the rail or outside a rival, went between horses leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and bested the others. DYNAMIC HOST chased a bit off the rail, came out on the backstretch, moved up three then four wide nearing the last turn, angled in and tracked the runner-up just off the fence leaving the final turn and weakened in the stretch. FLY LEXIS FLY pulled three deep then outside a rival and steadied on the first turn, dueled then inched away and angled in through the stretch the first time, dueled again leaving the second turn and on the backstretch, dropped back on the final turn and weakened. ROMP (ARG) took the early lead inside, dueled or stalked along the rail then a bit off the fence nearing the last turn, dropped back on that turn and had little left for the stretch.
