NATIVE GOLD DIGGER broke out and bumped a rival, sped to the lead outside a foe, angled in on the backstretch, kicked clear into the second turn and proved best under a brisk hand ride. GO FALON unhurried off the inside early, split horses on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and outfinished a rival late for second. MAYVILLE off a bit awkwardly, pulled her way along three deep to force the early pace, bid outside the winner on the backstretch, stalked that one off the rail into and on the second turn, then could not match strides and lost the place late. FRANTIC FRANCES came off the rail leaving the first turn, chased outside a rival on the backstretch, dropped back between foes leaving the second turn and weakened. TABARCIA broke out a bit, angled in and saved ground stalking the winner and weakened. BLOND DEL settled just off the inside early, angled to the rail on the first turn, continued inside and did not rally. FRENCH PARFAIT bumped and squeezed back at the start, settled off the inside, went wide on the second turn and into the stretch and failed to menace .
