Footnotes

MOROCCO squeezed a bit at the start, settled off the rail, moved up five wide on the turn and six wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up at the wire. EL CURIOSO angled in and saved ground off the pace, moved up inside leaving the turn, came out past midstretch, surged to the lead late but was caught on the line. LOVE ALL THE WAY went up between horses to duel for the lead, took a short advantage nearing midstretch but settled for third. PIE N BURGER had speed inside and dueled for the lead, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. QUINTON'S GOLD went up three deep to duel on a short lead, battled outside a rival in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. LEGENDARY WEAVE off a bit awkwardly, chased between horses on the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. BIG LEAGUE moved up inside on the backstretch, split horses into the turn, came outside a rival into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. RIYADH CITY close up chasing five wide on the backstretch and six wide into the turn, dropped back four wide on the bend and weakened. SIGN OF FIRE angled in and settled outside a rival on the backstretch and turn and did not rally. PRECISION CUT settled off the inside on the backstretch and turn and failed to menace. DISGUYS DALIMIT lugged out some early but chased between horses then off the rail, dropped back on the turn and had little left. ROMANZO close up stalking four and five wide on the backstretch, continued between horses wide on

the turn and gave way.
