SEA JEWEL chased outside on the backstretch, advanced boldly three deep on the turn, took the lead outside the pacesetter into the stretch and drew clear under a steady hand ride. AIN'T IT SWEEP sped between horses to the early lead, dueled inside, inched away into the turn, was no match for the winner in the drive but clearly second best. ROUSING AGAIN close up stalking the pace inside, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and edged a foe for third. DEVIOUS IMPACT broke slowly, saved ground in midpack, came out into the stretch and was edged for the show. SASHAYING SLEW pulled her way between horses to stalk the pace, continued a bit off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. SILKY SUMMER prompted the pace three deep on the backstretch then stalked outside a rival into and on the turn and also weakened in the lane. WESTERNIZE unhurried off the rail on the backstretch, went outside a rival on the turn and failed to menace. IRRESISTIBLE steadied in an awkward start, saved ground, came out into the stretch and did not rally. GOLDEN PENNY chased outside then off the rail on the turn and weakened. COMPOSURE hesitated to be off slowly, moved up outside on the backstretch angled in for the turn and lacked a further response.
