### Footnotes

LIFE'S PLEASURES saved ground off the early pace, moved up inside on the second turn, came out leaving that turn and three deep into the stretch, rallied to the front under urging past midstretch and pulled clear. SAINTLY PERSUASION sped between horses to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, was no match for the winner in the final furlong but saved the place. UNLIMITED FAITH four wide into the first turn, chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and edged a rival for third. A QUEENS TALE three deep into the first turn, stalked the pace outside then off the rail, came out some into the stretch and was edged for the show. QUIET MINISTER angled in on the first turn and saved ground unhurried early, remained inside and improved position in the stretch. ALICES SILVER LADY three deep into the first turn, stalked off the rail on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch. JOYFUL BALLAD washy at the gate, stalked inside, came off the rail on the second turn and also weakened. QUE BONITA chased outside a rival or off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. NAZAREEN tracked the pace between horses, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
