MEMBERSHIP COFFEE chased between horses then a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to collar the runner-up late. BEST FRIEND GRACIE chased off the rail, went around a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole, inched away and just failed to hold off the winner. EASY OBSESSION dueled inside on the backstretch, steadied and dropped back into the turn, came out into the stretch and gained the show. SPECIAL FAVOR angled in and dueled three deep then outside a rival on the turn, took the lead again into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MAYACAMA settled a bit off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. AURORING STAR veered out sharply at the start, settled wide on the backstretch and outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CAN YOU IMAGINE dueled between horses on the backstretch and inside on the turn and weakened in the stretch. OLYMPIC EXPERIENCE a bit slow into stride, settled inside, saved ground on the turn and did not rally. STORMIN LUCY settled outside, came five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. CATCH THE JOY chased outside, angled in alongside a rival on the turn and weakened. COLOMINAS chased between horses then off the rail, angled to the inside on the turn and also weakened. BAKERSFIELD CHAMP angled in and settled inside, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
