ROMANESQUE settled outside then a bit off the rail, moved up along the fence on the second turn, slipped through inside into the stretch and gained the lead then pulled clear under urging. REDMEANSGO saved ground off the pace, advanced on the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and gained the place. QUINTARA dueled between horses then inside on the first turn, stalked a bit off the rail on the backstretch and second turn, was no match for the top pair in the final furlong but held third. BLAZING BARTOK dueled three deep then outside a rival on the first turn, angled in on the backstretch, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch and weakened. AN ANNIKA MOMENT pulled her way along off the rail then angled in, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and did not rally. OLE CHERYL had speed inside then stalked off the rail, angled out into the stretch and weakened. SISTER MARY HUGH hit the gate in a bit of a slow start, angled in on the first turn, came out on the backstretch, found the inside in the stretch and lacked a rally. O K TOPLESS chased outside a rival then off the rail, dropped back on the second turn and weakened.
