Footnotes

A LIL DUMAANI stalked outside a rival then between foes leaving the turn, came three deep into the stretch, rallied to the lead under left handed urging a sixteenth out and won clear. CAMO close up stalking the pace inside, came out into the stretch, split foes past midstretch and gained the place inside. I AM GAME stalked outside a rival then three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch, gained the lead outside rivals in midstretch, battled between horses in deep stretch and held third. TIGLEY dueled outside a rival, put a head in front between foes in upper stretch, fought back off the rail past midstretch, then weakened late. WARRINGTON allowed to settle outside a rival, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PATRIATE had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. COOLERATOR saved ground off the pace, came out some in late stretch and did not rally. ONE HOT STORM chased outside a rival, dropped back three deep early on the second turn, angled in some and weakened.
