OFFLEE WILD BOYS stalked outside, bid three deep on the turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away and proved best under some urging. SWISS HERO dueled between horses then stalked inside on the turn, squeezed through in tight into the stretch, came off the rail in the drive and was second best. SWISS TART bumped at the start, pulled between horses then stalked off the rail, came out into the stretch and split rivals late for the show. CALL ME LATER angled in and chased inside, came out leaving the turn and again off heels in upper stretch and was edged for third three deep on the line. TAHOE

YODELER had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch and weakened some in the final furlong but was edged late for third. WARRENS HEARTTHROB broke out and bumped a rival then came in onto foes, steadied off heels early, chased off the rail then outside a rival to the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. TROUBLE RULES a bit slow to begin, settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and improved position. CURLY BOY angled in and chased inside, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. DESTINED JOURNEY in tight early, chased outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. BOLD FRESH sent between horses then dueled three deep or outside a rival, battled between horses on the turn, was brushed into the stretch and weakened. RED MOUNTAIN between horses early, settled inside, came out on the turn and again into the stretch and was not a threat. BEER FRIDAY a bit slow to begin and steadied in tight in the opening strides, angled in and settled just off the rail and was outrun.
