Footnotes

SHESKEY had good early speed and angled in, set a pressured pace inside then inched away on the backstretch, kicked clear on the second turn, responded when the runner-up loomed into the stretch and proved best under some urging. SMIL'N FROM ABOVE chased off the rail, split horses in a bit tight into the second turn, advanced toward the inside on that turn and into the stretch and was clearly second best. WARREN'S GENIUS saved ground off the pace, went between horses on the second turn, regained the rail leaving that turn and picked up the show. ARGUE MY CASE stalked off the rail then briefly between horses into the second turn, continued just off the inside and weakened. PORTFOLIO four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep then four wide on the second turn, angled in some into the stretch and lacked a further response. ROMAN CHIC fractious in the gate, pressed the pace between horses on the first turn, stalked between foes on the backstretch, steadied in tight into the second turn and weakened. GIVEITUPFORTHELADY (GB) chased outside or off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. ZEES CHRIS was in a good position stalking the pace inside, steadied in tight along the rail early on the second turn, fell back and weakened. WARREN'S MY QUEEN settled outside or off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. WOODMAN'S LASS stalked between horses, fell back some on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened.
