Footnotes

DRY SUMMER chased the pace on the inside down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, came out at the top of the stretch, rallied three deep, took the lead inside the sixteenth marker and held to the wire. FOREST BOY broke inward at the start and bumped a rival, pressed the pace on the outside into the turn, bid for command approaching the quarter pole, took over the lead at the top of the stretch, could not hold off the winner but was clearly second best. TITLE CONTENDER was bumped and steadied between horses at the start, moved up to set the pace on the inside down the backstretch, dueled inside around the turn, relinquished command at the top of the lane and weakened on the inside through the final furlong. POWER BROKER chased on the outside down the backstretch and three deep around the turn, came into the lane three wide, remained well off the rail through the stretch drive and did not offer the necessary rally. GREELEY AWESOME chased the pace on the outside down the backstretch, weakened between foes on the turn and fell back in the lane.
