STAKES San Diego H. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$3,000 additional to start, with \$200,000 Guaranteed, of which \$120,000 to first, \$40,000 to second, \$24,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth and \$4,000 to fifth. The San Diego Handicap has been selected as one of the Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" Challenge Races. The nominated winner of the San Diego Handicap will be entitled to automatic entry into the 2012 running of the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile. The nominated winner will also be entitled to have pre-entry and entry fees waived (\$30,000 value) for the Championship race, and will be entitled to receive a travel stipend of \$10,000 (US) if traveling from a location in North America or \$20,000 (US) if traveling internationally. To be eligible for the 2012 Breeders' Cup Championships to be held at Santa Anita on November 2 and 3, 2012, all horses must be pre-entered by noon (Eastern time at the designated pre-entry locations) by October 22, 2012. Winner must be Breeders' Cup nominated by pre-entry deadline to receive Challenge rewards. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Nominations Closed Thursday, July 19, 2012 with 13.

RAIL TRIP three deep early, dueled outside the runner-up throughout, put a head in front into the stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. JOHN SCOTT had speed between foes then angled in, set a pressured pace along the inside, fought back from the rail through the stretch and continued gamely to the wire. KETTLE CORN fractious in the gate, stalked inside then a bit off the rail, went between horses on the backstretch and second turn and went on willingly to the end. TAKE CONTROL settled a bit off the rail chasing the pace, swung four wide into the stretch and finished well. MOBILIZED stalked outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch and second turn, came four wide into the stretch and was outfinished. PRAYER FOR RELIEF close up tracking the pace outside a rival, continued three wide into and on the second turn and into the stretch and could not quite summon the needed late kick. TRES BORRACHOS secured a good position along the inside early, saved ground stalking the pace to the stretch and weakened.
