TOO FAST TO PASS a bit slow to begin, came off the rail and chased between rivals, angled three deep into the stretch and rallied under urging while drifting in some late to get up on the line. LAUGH AT LIFE had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, kicked clear, held on well then came out under left handed urging to bump a rival in the shadow of the wire. HUMOROUS stalked inside, came out in upper stretch and finished willingly then steadied when bumped between foes a jump from the end. TIZAPLAYER had speed between horses and dueled outside a rival, stalked leaving the turn, continued just off the rail in midstretch then angled in and was coming back toward the inside late. MYSTICAL MARK settled off the rail, angled to the inside leaving the backstretch, rode the rail on the turn, came out a bit in late stretch and improved position in the drive. THE WHOLE DEAL stalked off the rail then three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. JETS TO BRAZIL chased off the rail, came out leaving the turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. DISARM stalked outside then four wide, dropped back off the rail on the turn and gave way. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the bumping at the wire but made no change when they ruled the incident occurred too late to alter the original order of finish.
