Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided, provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any unearned Breeders' Cup Fund monies will revert to the Fund.

KONA GOLD chased along the inside early then was taken off the rail on the backstretch, moved up leaving the turn, took a short lead between horses in upper stretch, brushed with the runner-up under left handed urging in deep stretch but gamely prevailed. LOVE THAT RED allowed to settle outside on the backstretch, moved up off the rail on the turn and three deep into the stretch, bid outside the winner, brushed with that one in deep stretch and continued willingly to be second best. LEXICON sped to the early lead and angled in, dueled inside a rival on the backstretch, inched away on the turn, offered little resistance when the top pair challenged but held third. SON OF A PISTOL bobbled at the start, settled between horses on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. HIGHLAND GOLD saved ground off the pace, was roused leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and also lacked a rally. LEVELLED (GB) threw his head at the start, pulled his way up outside LEXICON and took a short lead, dueled outside that one on the backstretch and into the turn, dropped back some on the bend, continued just off the rail and weakened. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the incident was minor and did not warrant a disqualification.
