

Footnotes

SKIMMING sped outside a rival to the early lead, angled in on the first turn, kicked clear on the backstretch, responded when FUTURAL loomed nearing and through the stretch and held on gamely under urging. FUTURAL bobbled slightly at the start, angled in and saved ground off the pace, moved up inside leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, came out on that bend, loomed a threat behind the winner approaching and through the stretch but could not catch that one. CAPTAIN STEVE broke in and brushed a rival, settled outside a foe on the first turn then three deep early on the backstretch, angled in and advanced a bit off the rail into and on the second turn, came out in upper stretch but lacked the necessary response. BUDROYALE three deep into the first turn, chased off the rail or between foes, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. DIG FOR IT between horses early, angled in and saved ground, dropped back on the backstretch and failed to menace. FREEDOM CREST pulled his way along inside early, came a bit off the rail on the backstretch and outside a rival into the second turn, drifted out a bit into the stretch and weakened. SPICY STUFF four wide into the first turn, chased outside, drifted out and dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
