Footnotes

LUMBERYARD JACK stalked the pace just off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter into and on the final turn, took the lead nearing the stretch, kicked clear and proved best under urging. LIME RICKEY chased outside a rival or off the rail, came out into the stretch and gained the place. RENEGADE STORM saved ground off the pace, moved up inside into the stretch, came out past midstretch and split horses on the line for third. IMPONENTE PURSE (BRZ) chased a bit off the rail then a rival on the final turn, came out in upper stretch and just missed third four wide on the wire. FALCON ROCK (IRE) saved ground stalking the pace, came out a bit into the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and was edged for a minor award. THE UNUSUAL ONE took the early lead outside a rival into the first turn, set the pace under a rating hold a bit off the rail then inside on the backstretch, fought back when challenged from along the rail on the final turn and weakened in the stretch. SOUL CANDY pulled some early, chased just off the rail then inside on the last turn, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and was in a bit tight late. TAKE A YARD allowed to settle outside a rival then off the rail, went alongside a foe on the final turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally.
