ROYAL IMPORT (GB) unhurried along the inside early, split horses leaving the backstretch, moved up inside on the second turn and into the stretch, rallied along the rail under left handed urging to gain the lead late and gamely prevailed. COLUDA sped to the early lead and angled in, dueled inside into the first turn, inched clear, kicked away into the second turn, drifted out some from the whip in midstretch, fought back alongside the winner in deep stretch and was edged late. MEGARIDE saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and went willingly to the wire. MAN CHESTER MAN chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ST. JOEL chased three deep, was forced out midway on the second turn, came into the stretch three wide and did not rally. WARREN'S KONG settled outside a rival, also was forced out on the second turn,

came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MAKER (ARG) saved ground chasing the pace throughout and lacked a response in the stretch. GUIDING HAND stalked between horses, dropped back into and through the stretch, gave way and was eased in the final furlong. BENCH THE JUDGE pressed the pace outside the runner-up then stalked off the rail or alongside a rival, was pulled up in distress between horses on the second turn and vanned off.
