CYCLOTRON sped to the early lead off the rail, angled in and dueled inside, responded when headed in the stretch, had the rider lose the whip past the eighth pole but gamely came back on to prove best. BIG CITY HIT stalked inside then bid between horses and dueled outside the winner on the turn and in the stretch, gained the advantage in midstretch but was outgamed. APALACHEE TIGER stalked outside then bid three deep on the backstretch and turn and bested the others. COCHA BAMBА settled off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. BLUE CORNER broke in and a bit slowly, settled inside stalking the pace and lacked a response in the stretch. CONNECTIONS chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the turn and did not rally. DIXIE GLOW allowed to settle outside, came three deep into the stretch and failed to menace. PROP FIVE chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out a bit into the stretch and was not a factor.
