STAKES San Diego H. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$3,000 additional to start, with \$200,000 Guaranteed, of which \$120,000 to first, \$40,000 to second, \$24,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth and \$4,000 to fifth. The San Diego Handicap has been selected as one of the Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" Challenge Races. The nominated winner of the San Diego Handicap will be entitled to automatic entry into the 2011 running of the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile. The nominated winner will also be entitled to have pre-entry and entry fees waived (\$30,000 value) for the Championship race, and will be entitled to receive a travel stipend of \$10,000 (US) if traveling from a location in North America or \$20,000 (US) if traveling internationally. To be eligible for the 2011 Breeders' Cup Championships to be held at Churchill Downs on November 4 and 5, 2011, all horses must be pre-entered by noon (Eastern time at the designated pre-entry locations) by October 24, 2011. Winner must be nominated by pre-entry deadline to receive Challenge rewards. Weights Sunday, July 24. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Thursday July 21, 2011 with 11.

TRES BORRACHOS angled in and chased inside then a bit off the rail leaving the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, rallied under some urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. KEVLAR KID sped to the early lead inside, tugged a bit while setting the pace just off the rail, remained clear in midstretch, held on well to deep stretch, could not match the winner late but saved the place. SPURRIER settled off the pace inside, came out into the stretch, angled back in passing the eighth pole and finished well along the fence. OILISBLACKGOLD angled in and stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and was outfinished. DON TITO had speed outside the runner-up then stalked just off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, came out approaching the stretch, had the rider lose the whip when between foes just past the eighth pole and lacked the needed late kick. AGGIE ENGINEER chased three deep then alongside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the needed response. GOLDEN ITIZ stalked the pace outside a rival, came out three wide into the stretch and weakened. UH OH BANGO pulled early, settled off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch, dropped back and was eased late.
