FREE BEER angled in and stalked inside, came out on the second turn, took the lead between horses into the stretch, kicked clear under urging and proved best. B'S LUCKY STRIKE settled outside then three deep on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch, drifted in some in the drive and edged a rival for second. LUSTERDUST chased outside a rival then between horses into and on the second turn, angled to the inside into the stretch and was edged for the place. BRASS PLATE settled inside, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and improved position. NUGGETS PLEASE prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked off the rail, was between horses on the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and weakened. HUGHESY had speed inside then tugged a bit and set the pace a bit off the rail, continued just off the fence into the stretch and weakened. ABSOLUTE COURAGE stalked off the rail then three deep, came out five wide into the stretch with a bid and weakened in the final furlong. CALL FOR JUSTICE broke a bit slowly, pulled inside the settled along the rail, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. BEAU MAVERICK four wide early, stalked outside a rival then inside, dropped back into the stretch, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
