Footnotes

BEAU SOLEIL broke outward, had good early speed and dueled between horses then inside, inched away on the turn and won clear under urging. SUNSET PLACE crowded at the start, went between horses then chased outside, moved up outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and split horses late for second. R. BAGGIO chased outside and three deep into the turn, came five wide into the stretch and gained the show late. PERFECT MOON dueled three deep then outside the winner, stalked a bit off the rail in the turn, was no match in the stretch and lost a minor award late. JET WEST forced the early pace inside then stalked a bit off the rail and lacked the needed response in the stretch. FUSAICHI ROCK STAR chased inside then off the rail on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. BULLISTIC off a bit slowly and crowded, angled in on the backstretch, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. NORTH AMERICAN (BRZ) chased between horses, angled in on the turn and did not rally. YES

HE'S A PISTOL chased between horses then outside a rival, found the rail on the turn, continued inside, had the rider lose the whip late and weakened. RANSOM DEMANDED settled outside or off the rail, came five wide into the stretch and failed to menace. SALOP (ARG) saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened.
