**Footnotes**

UNION SOLDIER four wide into the first turn, chased outside, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, lugged in some in the drive but rallied under some left handed urging and strong handling to get up outside foes late. FREE LUNCH saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside then came out on the second turn and into the stretch, rallied between horses late to put a head in front nearing the wire and continued willingly. JOURNEYMAN sped to the early lead outside foes, angled in on the first turn and set the pace inside, held on well a bit off the rail in the stretch and also went on gamely to the end. JOKING SAM three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival, came out past midstretch and bested the rest. CONCERNING SUTTON between foes early, angled in and chased inside, moved up along the rail into the stretch but could not summon the necessary late kick. SAINT CHOCOLATE allowed to settle outside then alongside a rival, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out leaving that turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. JUST REBOOT IT settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, found the fence on the second turn and was not a threat. LIMITED WILL stalked a bit off the rail, dropped back between foes leaving the second turn and weakened. OCEANOR angled in and chased outside a rival, also dropped back between horses on the second turn and gave way. CEE'S DIZZY unhurried along the inside in the initial stages, fell back into and on the second turn and was through early.
